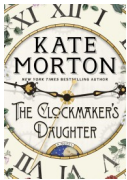

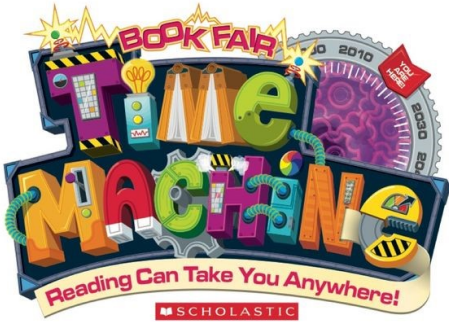

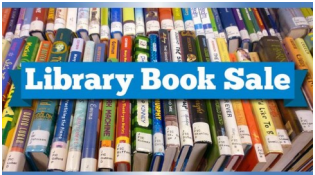
SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR
