

The Aspen View School Division voted unanimously for Rochester School to remain open for the 2022-2023 school year. After the fall enrollment numbers are established, the board will revisit and make the decision for the future of the school. This means WE NEED YOU TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD NOW! If the numbers meet the enrollment requirements, the board will consider keeping the school open longer. However, if the school does not meet the requirements, they will be forced to close at the end of the 2022-23 school year.

*If your child is eligible to attend Kindergarten in the 2022-23 school year (must be 5 years old by Dec. 31, 2022) please complete and submit an Aspen View Registration Form as soon as possible. 




